



Dan's Legacy's "Intro to Cook" job-skills program provides clinically supported training in cooking skills to youth aging out of care, Indigenous youth, young women survivors of gendered violence and new Canadians. These marginalized young people face many barriers to post-secondary educational opportunities or trades training, and Dan's Legacy is closing that gap.

Since the start of the program in February 2021, fourteen students have graduated from the program, and most have gone on to employment in the food services industry or have enrolled in further training to obtain Red Seal Certification.

Position Summary:

The **Chef Instructor**, supported by Dan's Legacy's counselling and outreach team, works with a cohort of young adult students with various mental health challenges. Training is provided to the Chef Instructor from the counselling team to learn best practices in supporting youth with trauma-based mental health challenges.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Develop a curriculum for classes
- Lead lectures and hands-on sessions
- Assign cooking projects and written assessments
- Performs other duties as assigned

Qualifications & Requirements:

- Must be double vaccinated against COVID-19
- A Criminal Record (Vulnerable Populations) Record check must be submitted prior to the start of employment
- Ability to travel to New Westminster where the program is located
- Be able to demonstrate basic computer literacy in standard office software programs, i.e., Word, Excel, Zoom, e-mail, and smartphone applications for administrative duties
- Teaching or employee training experience (preferred)
- Several years of cooking or restaurant management experience
- Strong communication skills
