Each year we host our Chefs' Charity Dinner in a different community, and on November 2nd we're coming to Langley! We're looking for organizations eager to help us reach out to youth at risk, and help change the trajectory of their lives.

We now know that trauma is at the core of mental health and addiction issues, and self-medicating with substances is one of the ways traumatized young people cope. The homeless youth you see on the street corner or the ones recruited into gangs often come from a background of unimaginable abuse, poverty or neglect.

Without intervention, within 3 to 5 years of aging out, youth from foster care are at the highest risk of lifelong mental health issues, entrenched addiction, overdose and suicide. The impact on families and communities is devastating – but Dan's Legacy is getting ahead of the issue.

Our therapists, social workers and outreach workers go directly to the youth wherever they are. We embed our therapists in local community organizations, making it even easier for the youth to find us. In Langley, we're working directly with the Youth Hub and the Lower Fraser Valley Aboriginal Society, and we accept referrals from Foundry.

ABOUT DAN'S LEGACY

Who was Dan? His dad was a chef which is where Dan developed a passion for cooking. Dan wanted to learn everything he could about sustainable "field-to-fork" practices, and he jumped at the chance to work for 3 weeks on a fishing boat – his dream summer job.

The dream became a nightmare as Dan was sexually assaulted while away at sea and had nowhere to turn for help.

Many trauma survivors try to medicate the pain away, and Dan was no different. Drugs were his only escape. The recovery programs he attended did not offer age-appropriate, trauma-informed therapy, which would have saved his life.

The pain lasted until his final day, when Dan died from an accidental overdose. He was only 19.

There are thousands of youth like Dan across the Lower Mainland who are dealing with trauma. Poverty, abuse, violence, and addiction defined their childhoods. Most grew up in foster care and are alone in the world.

Our therapists go directly to them wherever they are, we try not to have a wait list and our counselling services are free. We also make sure the youth have food, housing, and other programming that connects them to community.

No other organization in Metro Vancouver does what we do, and we have an over 50% success rate in helping youth to stabilize and begin working towards their education, employment and recovery goals. In the past year, we have helped over 600 youth overcome their mental health and addiction challenges and lead productive and fulfilling lives.

WRAP AROUND PROGRAMS

We have developed a number of wrap around programs which help to stabilize the youth and support our core counselling program:

- Fitness designed and facilitated by one of our therapists who is also a certified fitness instructor
- Indigenous Cultural Workshops designed and facilitated by an Indigenous Elder, this program helps connect Indigenous youth to community and culture
- Food Bank grocery hampers are supplied weekly to registered clients



INTRO TO COOK & DAN'S DINER PROGRAMS


Youth aging out of foster care typically have, on average, a grade 8 education, and most are dealing with mental health issues due to trauma experienced in childhood. These challenges present multiple barriers to accessing post-secondary educational or trades training opportunities. Dan's Legacy's "Intro to Cook" program provides 4-months of training in a commercial kitchen with professional chefs as well as paid work experiences. The entire program is clinically supported by our therapists, social workers and outreach workers, ensuring the youth have every chance to succeed. We just celebrated our 2-year anniversary, and are expanding the program with our "Dan's Diner" social enterprise in New Westminster. Youth in this program learn how to run a small food service operation, acquiring skills such as point-of-sale, inventory, and customer service. We are thrilled to have members of our "Intro to Cook" team helping us out each year, and we know you will be delighted to sample their creations at one of our Chef Appetizer stations.

CLIENT STORY

"Ron" (21) grew up bouncing back and forth between foster care and living with an aunt. When he first started counselling sessions with Dan's Legacy, he exhibited dangerous behaviour such as hard drug use, suicide ideation, and dissociative episodes that were sometimes criminal. But after six months of therapy, he is well into the trauma work, avoiding hard drugs and making plans to live instead of planning suicide. One of the self-regulation techniques was helping him to start playing a piano again. Dan's Legacy's therapist provided him with a donated piano and music – focusing on playing helps alleviate the tendency to dissociate. "Ron" is now in his second semester of an online college course, and he plans to work full time once he finishes the course.
