Each year we host our Chefs' Charity Dinner in a different community, and on November 16 we're coming to New Westminster! We're looking for organizations eager to help youth at risk and change the trajectory of their lives.

We now know that trauma is at the core of mental health and addiction issues, and self-medicating with substances is one of the ways traumatized young people cope. The homeless youth you see on the street corner or the ones recruited into gangs often come from a background of unimaginable abuse, poverty or neglect.

Without intervention, within 3 to 5 years of aging out, youth from foster care are at the highest risk of lifelong mental health issues, entrenched addiction, overdose and suicide. The impact on families and communities is devastating – but Dan's Legacy is getting ahead of the issue.

Our therapists, social workers and outreach workers go directly to the youth wherever they are. We embed our therapists in local community organizations, making it even easier for the youth to find us. Our office and Dan's Diner social enterprise are located in New Westminster, and we're working directly with Aunt Leah's Place, the Purpose Society, Union Gospel Mission, and Burnaby Neighbourhood House in the community next door.

ABOUT DAN'S LEGACY

Who was Dan? His dad was a chef which is where Dan developed a passion for cooking. Dan wanted to learn everything he could about sustainable “field-to-fork” practices, and he jumped at the chance to work for 3 weeks on a fishing boat – his dream summer job.

The dream became a nightmare as Dan was sexually assaulted while away at sea and had nowhere to turn for help.

Many trauma survivors try to medicate the pain away, and Dan was no different. Drugs were his only escape. The recovery programs he attended did not offer age-appropriate, trauma-informed therapy, which would have saved his life.

The pain lasted until his final day, when Dan died from an accidental overdose. He was only 19.

There are thousands of youth like Dan across the Lower Mainland who are dealing with trauma. Poverty, abuse, violence, and addiction defined their childhoods. Most grew up in foster care and are alone in the world.

Our therapists go directly to them wherever they are, we try not to have a wait list and our counselling services are free.

We also make sure the youth have food, housing, and other programming that connects them to community.

No other organization in Metro Vancouver does what we do, and the vast majority of our clients begin to stabilize and start working towards their education, employment and recovery goals within 4-6 months. In the past year, we have helped over 600 youth overcome their mental health and addiction challenges and lead productive and fulfilling lives.

WRAP AROUND PROGRAMS

We have developed a number of wrap around programs which help to stabilize the youth and support our core counselling program:

- Fitness - designed and facilitated by one of our therapists who is also a certified fitness instructor
- Food Bank - grocery hampers are supplied weekly to registered clients
- Community partners - we link our clients to the wrap-around programs of our 15 community partners across Metro Vancouver

DAN'S DINER JOB-SKILLS TRAINING

Youth aging out of foster care typically have, on average, a grade 8 education, and most are dealing with mental health issues due to trauma experienced in childhood. These challenges present multiple barriers to accessing post-secondary educational or trades training opportunities.

In our Dan's Diner job-skills training program, students learn professional cooking skills and business management, as well as valuable life-skills, which will help them secure employment in the food service industry. They also assist with our catering services, giving them even more hands-on experience in hospitality.

We are thrilled to have the Dan's Diner team included in our roster of guest chefs each year at the dinner.



CLIENT STORY

“Chris” is a 22-year-old non-binary Métis youth who experienced serious and repeated trauma throughout childhood. When he first connected with Dan’s Legacy’s therapist, he was unable to care for himself. With intensive trauma-informed therapy, “Chris” not only cares for himself but also looks after his girlfriend and his sister. Integral to his healing has been access to healthy food through Dan’s Legacy’s food bank and Haven’s weekly hot meal program, both of which are supported by our recovered food collection program. Haven provides a sense of community to many youth, most of whom have aged out of foster care and are struggling to survive in the Lower Mainland on income assistance. Most of “Chris” monthly cheque pays for rent, and without Dan’s Legacy’s food bank he would be facing serious food insecurity issues. “Chris” is an excellent cook and takes pride in not only cooking for his housemates, but regularly invites some of the other youth over for a hot meal. Being the person who takes care of others has had a positive impact on “Chris” self-esteem, which helps to maintain mental health stability.
