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Each year we host our Chefs Charity Dinner in a different community, and on November 8 we're thrilled to be coming back to Surrey! We're looking for organizations eager to help youth at risk and change the trajectory of their lives.

We now know that trauma is at the core of mental health and addiction issues, and self-medicating with substances is one of the ways traumatized young people cope. The homeless youth you see on the street corner or the ones recruited into gangs often come from a background of unimaginable abuse, poverty or neglect.

Without intervention, within 3 to 5 years of aging out, youth from foster care are at the highest risk of lifelong mental health issues, entrenched addiction, overdose and suicide. The impact on families and communities is devastating but Dan's Legacy is getting ahead of the issue.

Our therapists, social workers and outreach workers go directly to the youth wherever they are. We embed our therapists in local community organizations, making it even easier for the youth to find us. In Surrey, we're working directly with Solid State and the Black Arts Centre, Vine Youth Clinic at Alex House, North Surrey Learning Centre (Surrey School District) and the Foundry Surrey.

ABOUT DAN



Dan was a vibrant, kind, and compassionate young man, eager to live his dream of one day becoming a chef like his dad.

One summer he eagerly accepted a job on a fishing boat to learn more about sustainable fishing practices – and that’s when the dream turned into a nightmare. After weeks of physical and sexual abuse, Dan returned and turned to drugs to numb the psychological pain of that experience. Two intakes into substance abuse recovery programs didn’t help, because neither was age appropriate or provided trauma-informed support.

On the morning of August 27, 2006, his mother found him unresponsive from a fatal overdose.

Dan was only 19.

To keep his memory alive, and to ensure other youth received the trauma-informed counselling support that would have saved Dan’s life, in 2006 his family formed this charity in his name. In 2024, the Foundation worked with over 700 youth.

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WRAP-AROUND PROGRAMS

DAN'S DINER JOB-SKILLS TRAINING



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We have developed a number of wrap-around programs which help to stabilize the youth and support our core counselling program:

Fitness - designed and facilitated by one of our therapists who is also a certified fitness instructor

Food Bank - grocery hampers are supplied weekly to registered clients

Community Partners - we link our clients to the wrap-around programs of our 15 community partners across Metro Vancouver

Youth aging out of foster care typically have, on average, a grade 8 education, and most are dealing with mental health issues due to trauma experienced in childhood. These challenges present multiple barriers to accessing post-secondary educational or trades training opportunities.

In our Cook Training and Dan's Diner Social Enterprise job-skills training program, students learn professional cooking skills and business management, as well as valuable life-skills, which will help them secure employment in the food service industry. They also assist with our catering services, giving them even more hands-on experience in hospitality.

We are thrilled to have the Dan's Diner team included in our roster of guest chefs each year at our event.

CLIENT STORY

“CHRIS”



“Chris” is a 22-year-old non-binary Métis youth who experienced serious and repeated trauma throughout childhood. When he first connected with Dan’s Legacy’s therapist, he was unable to care for himself. With intensive trauma-informed therapy, “Chris” is now able to look after himself as well as his girlfriend and his sister. Integral to his healing has been access to healthy food through Dan’s Legacy’s Grocery Hamper program, which is supported by our Recovered Food Collection program. Many of our youth clients are homeless and all of them are hungry, and our Food Hamper Program gives them an autonomous “shopping” experience and helps to mitigate their food insecurity issues.

“Chris” is an excellent cook and takes pride in not only cooking for his housemates, but regularly invites some of the other youth over for a hot meal. Being the person who takes care of others has had a positive impact on “Chris’” self-esteem, which helps to maintain mental health stability. Dan’s Legacy’s therapist is encouraging him to enroll in our Cook Training program at the next intake.
